

Mathematics

Here at St Patrick's we use a wide range of tools to assess and educate children in mathematics. One of these tools is *Essential Assessment* and its partner program *My Numeracy*.

Essential Assessment

Your children will already have participated in some *Essential Assessment* tests this year; we teachers use these as both pre-tests (to help decide what children need to learn next) and post-tests (to measure the effectiveness of mathematics lessons). Each test is linked to the topic(s) we are covering in the classroom each week and teachers set the appropriate test levels to suit each child's needs. Whenever a student completes one of these tests, they are automatically assigned a series of individualised online maths activities through the *My Numeracy* program.

My Numeracy

Each My Numeracy activity is based around a specific mathematical skill. When a child struggles to demonstrate that skill during an assessment, then the relevant activity is assigned to their My Numeracy account. Students can


